HAGUE BOAT LAUNCH

Motion by Councilwoman Kuenzel, seconded by S. Ramant to open the meeting at 6:00 pm. All voting yes. Motion carried.

Supervisor Frasier welcomed the guest and reported that Lindsay from Monolith Solar Associates LLC would like to meet with the Town Board at the April 8, 2014 meeting. Supervisor Frasier will see if she is available to come at 6:15 pm, and also Dave Decker would like to meet with the Board on April 7 at 4:45 pm to discuss the salt shed grant.

The Town Board discussed the two proposals for the Boat Launch. They discussed again the closure of the launch. Councilman Fitzgerald would like to see a swipe card or camera monitor to allow the local residents to launch their boats. Councilwoman Kuenzel & Ramant explained that the LGPC wants the Town to have a Park Attendant to regulate the launch.

The Park Committee recommended proposal #1.

Resolution #48 of 2014: Hague Boat Launch Regulations for 2014.  
Introduced by S. Ramant, seconded by R. Meola

Resolved, that the following schedule be adopted for the 2014 season. The hours may be extended or altered at the discretion of the Park Committee.

**Hague Boat Launch Regulations**

Hague launch attendants will be on duty at the Hague Boat Launch during the posted opening times. When no attendant is on duty, the launch will be closed and locked. The opening times and dates for 2014 are listed below. The hours may be extended through the use of volunteers who have undergone training on the responsibilities of launch attendants.

Signage with the opening times will be posted at the launch. The attendant will ensure that anyone who launches a boat is informed and aware of the opening times and understands that they can only delaunch during those hours.

The Town reserves the right to close the launch during special events or other times when it is deemed necessary.

A key will be provided to the Hague Volunteer Fire Department to enable them to have 24 x 7 access to the launch for emergency use.

The Town may enter into an individual agreement with a commercial marina operator to permit usage of the Hague launch outside of regular operating hours. The marina operator must have a signed Memorandum of Understanding with the Lake George Park Commission certifying that he/she will only launch boats that can legally enter Lake George (either inspected or Lake-George-only boats).
